## COBBOLD'S WHARF

"S7" GAUGE



### **Layout Description / Programme Notes:**

Cobbold's Wharf is a prototype layout based on the part of Ipswich Docks that lies between the New Cut, through which the River Orwell was diverted in the 19th century, and the non-tidal Wet Dock. The team are aiming to capture the atmosphere of Ipswich Docks in the 1950's and 60's and beside the Maltings you can see one of our Tram Engines that were a common sight at the docks. The layout has been wired for full DCC and uses the MERG CBUS system for point control. Being a slightly wider gauge of 33mm and therefore more accurate, it does also benefit from much tighter tolerances than finescale O gauge.

Stock is provided by members and includes a J65 (number 68211), Class 15 diesel, 08 shunter, tram engines and mixed RTR models together with those that are kit built. All are built including DCC and sound.
